Fire-innovation competition	<u>Each Fire-station</u> can enter one competition entry for <u>every block of twenty sponsors</u> , or <u>part block of twenty sponsors above the first twenty sponsors</u> .
Innovation development support	All participating Fire-Stations will receive innovation development assistance in the form of structured modules. Assisting them to establish successful innovation hubs / focus groups.
Updates and suggestion reports	An important element of the initiative is the information of developments that have been proposed across all the hubs. This will enable a Fire-station to assess suggestion, new methods and new equipment options (by other regions) with regards to the feasibility for their region and challenges.
Support to capitalize on ideas	First Responders Innovation Hub members will receive guidance to capitalize and develop their ideas.
